STUDENT SUPPORT LINE + VIRTUAL COUNSELING

Attending college is an exciting life experience for our students, but it can also be a time of stress, change and adjustment. Mississippi State University has partnered with My Student Support Program (MySSP) to help our students be successful. MySSP provides free, confidential mental health and well-being support to all Mississippi State students. MySSP includes many resources such as 24/7 free mental health support by phone or text through the app.

Students can receive help anytime with:

- adapting to changes or challenges
- being successful at school
- navigating relationships with friends and family
- handling feelings or sadness, loneliness, homesickness, or more
- or to just to talk to someone.

Checklist for students planning to graduate:

- Confirm with advisor that all degree requirements have been met. CAPP degree audit system is a guide for this, but we recommend consulting advisors to be sure.
- Log in to myState (Banner) and select "Apply for a degree."
- Complete ALL steps of the application and select SUBMIT.
- Students will receive a confirmation number signifying the application was successfully submitted.
- Account balance must be paid in full. This includes everything from tuition to parking and library fines. (Students with an unpaid balance will not receive a diploma.)
- Students who plan to walk in the December commencement ceremony must order caps and gowns through Barnes & Noble bookstore.
- Students who have taken courses away from MSU at any time (summer courses at home, etc.) need to have all transfer transcripts sent to MSU. If a transcript containing a required course has not been received, a student may not be eligible to graduate.



The Fall 2022 main campus commencement ceremonies will be held on Friday, December 9, 2022, in the Humphrey Coliseum on our Starkville Campus (details below). Graduates must

arrive no later than 30 minutes prior to their ceremony start time and should be dressed in their regalia at check-in.

Please read through these important notes about the ceremonies:

- Security screening will take place upon entry and all bags are subject to search.
- Please DO NOT bring personal items into the Coliseum. There will not be any storage areas available, and anything left in seats will be thrown away.
- Guest attendance is limited to 8 guests per graduate and all guests must have tickets to enter (regardless of age). Ticket information can be found in the section below.
- Guest seating will be general admission and first-come, first-served. Please DO NOT sit in the roped off sections behind the stage.
- Graduates will be seated after check-in and an entrance processional will not be included in the ceremonies. However, graduates will still walk across the stage as they are announced and congratulated.
- Graduates will receive a diploma cover as they cross the stage. Physical contact with anyone on stage is prohibited.
- Once graduates are recognized by walking across the stage, they will not return to their seats. Instead, they will be guided to the photography area to take a professional photo before exiting the Coliseum.
- Guests are expected to begin leaving the Coliseum once their graduate exits the stage. Please do this quietly with respect to other graduates and guests.
- Re-entry into the Coliseum will not be permitted, and each ceremony should last roughly 1.5 hours total.
- There will be no concessions available during the ceremonies. Guests may bring one clear water bottle into the Coliseum.
- Please plan to remove all vehicles from the parking areas promptly following the morning ceremony to make space for guests attending the afternoon ceremony.
- Any guests who are unable to attend may view a livestream of the ceremonies online (links can be found below).
- All cords, stoles, pins, etc. that are worn with graduation regalia come from the individual
 organizations that the graduates may be involved with. Graduates can reach out to the
 MSU-affiliated groups that they are part of to see if they offer any graduation adornments.
 These items must be approved in order to distribute them to graduates.

Instructions for claiming guest tickets will be emailed to graduates and updated online here in late November 2022. There is no cost, and each graduate may claim up to 8 tickets. Please check back in late November for additional information regarding commencement guest tickets.

WINTER Housing APPLICANTS

Winter housing applications are now available for current students who plan to spend the winter holiday break at MSU. Winter housing is only available to current fall residents who will remain living on campus for the following spring semester.

To apply, students will need to visit their <u>Housing Portal</u>. The rate for winter housing is \$1,000 and will be charged to any student staying after December 9 thru January 13. Costs will not be pro-rated under any circumstances.



Does your Bulldog need a ride to the Golden Triangle Regional Airport?

Encourage your student to consider riding the Golden Triangle Regional Airport (GTRA) Express Route in order to make their next flight out of Starkville. The GTRA Express Route provides transportation services from the HWY 12 West Walmart stop and the Mill at MSU stop. No reservation is needed for these stops.

On-campus accommodations are available through a 48 hour reservation. Students who live on campus are able to reserve a pick-up day and time with the GTRA Express Route and coordinate getting picked up at the nearest shuttle stop by their residence hall. To make an on-campus reservation, students can call MSU Parking and Transit Services at 662.325.5204.

Students can follow the GTRA Express Route on the **<u>DoubleMap</u>** app for a real-time location and estimated time of arrival (ETA).

Student Account Reminders

In an effort to foster responsible financial management and reduce student debt, we would like to remind you about important payment requirements related to student accounts.

• Payment Plans are Available

MSU is pleased to offer payment plans that will allow you to pay tuition, residence halls, meal plans and other expenses through monthly installments. Learn more at **Pay My Bill**.

• Payment Due Dates <u>are</u> on the 1st of Each Month

Your monthly billing statement will be available around the 15th of each month, and the due date is the 1st of the following month. For example, a December 15th billing statement will have a due date of January 1st.

• Bills Must be Paid Before the Semester Begins or your Student's Schedule will be subject to Cancellation

Before classes begin, you must pay the full balance on your student's account (net of aid) **or** be enrolled in a payment plan. Otherwise, your student's schedule will be subject to cancellation, and if they are living in campus housing, they will not be permitted to move into their residence hall.

PLEASE NOTE: If your account balance is displayed in (parentheses), it means you have a (credit balance), and MSU owes you a refund. A (credit balance) means you do not need to make a payment or enroll in payment plan.

Money Matter\$

Past due holds and late fees will be assessed on the October 15th statement. Holds prevent preregistration for the upcoming semester. Remember, classes fill up fast! In order to be eligible for pre-registration, students must be enrolled in an active payment plan or have a current account balance of zero.

As of October 1, the 2023-24 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available to complete. Students can complete the <u>FAFSA</u> online. The FAFSA will ask for income data from the 2021 tax year. Some federal aid has limited funding. Therefore, to receive maximum consideration for all aid types we encourage your student to complete the FAFSA today.

Scholarships

Do you have a student interested in being considered for scholarship resources for the upcoming academic year? The scholarship applications for the 2023-2024 Academic Year will open on October 1. Current students may apply for competitive, private, and departmental scholarships by completing the General Scholarship Application. The priority date for submitting these applications is March 1, 2023.
